Achmad Dedi Faozi, a Master of Sciences graduate, is currently appointed as the Archivist at the National Archives of the Republic of Indonesia (ANRI). As the Head of Archives Reproduction and Digitization, his primary responsibilities include the transfer of archival media at ANRI in both paper and audiovisual formats. The digitized archives become accessible public information through reading rooms, acting as physical preservation and archival information backup. Dedi is deeply invested in the issues surrounding social archives and archival preservation in both physical and digital domains.

His experience encompasses a variety of training and webinar participations. These include the Training of Presidential Archives Management with KOICA in Seoul, South Korea in 2021 (Online), Webinars on Audio-visual Archives and Digital Preservation of Archives hosted by ANRI from 2020 to 2022, and the Training of Authentication and Graphology of the Originality of Archives in 2022.

In 2021, Dedi took the stage as a speaker at the International Council on Archives (ICA) Virtual Conference. His presentation titled "Existence of Archivist Professions in the VUCA era" focused on a case study of Archiving Provisional Voters Lists as the Ministry of Home Affairs and the Election Commission in the 2019 Elections. His dedication to his profession and constant efforts to evolve with the digital age are commendable.
